Contains non-plant food ingredients

Active Ingredient: 3% by wt.

Bacillus amyloliquefaciens. 1×10^8 CFU/g

Inactive Ingredients: 97% by weight

Bacilifol is a naturally occurring living bacterium which, when added to the soil, modifies the micro ecosystem to enhance available nutrient uptake.

DIRECTIONS

Foliar application: Apply 1 lb. of product per acre in appropriate water use rate to assure uniform coverage. Apply foliar or in between rows WEEKLY UNTIL TWO WEEKS BEFORE HARVESTING. First application should be pre plant with follow-up treatments at 10–15-day intervals if necessary. Apply 2 lbs./acre if plants appear to be under stress.

Tubers: Mix solution with 2 tablespoons of product per gallon of water and coat tubers thoroughly prior to planting.

Seed treatment: Make solution with 7.2 grams (1.5 teaspoons) of product per 5 oz of water. Use adequate mixture to thoroughly coat seeds.

Garden/greenhouse use: Mix 1 tablespoon per gallon of water and apply to soil around plants, vegetables and trees. Thoroughly moisten the treated surface. Apply in and around root zone before planting. Supplement with seed treatment instructions above for better coverages. Can also be foliar applied post-emergence if desired.

Bacilifol is beneficial for plant health as it acts as a natural plant health improvement additive.
